

## SEPTEMBER 12, 2006

The Harriman City council met in regular session Tuesday September 12th, 2006 at 7:30 p.m. in the Conference Room of the Harriman Municipal/Utility Building. The Honorable Jerry Davis Mayor was present and presiding. Mayor called meeting to order. Roll call of Council was as follows:

Mayor Davis asked for a motion to approve the minutes from 9/5. Councilmember Gallaher made the motion and was seconded by Councilmember Tedder. The motion passed with a unanimous "Aye".

Mayor Davis asked for a motion to pay the bills. Councilmember Tedder made the motion and was seconded by Councilmember Morris. The motion passed with a unanimous "Aye".

Mayor Davis called to hear delegations.

Terry Lawson with Emory Gap Baptist Church came before council inquiring if anything could be done about Happy Hawg selling beer. Mayor Davis stated that the church would have in writing their answer from City Attorney Harold Balcom, next week. Mr. Lawson asked if the council would consider putting the 500ft limit back in the charter regarding how close a vendor which sells beer could be from a church or a school. Councilmember Morris stated that a resolution could be drawn up before the next council meeting and voted on at that time.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

**Pine Ridge Road Project**-Councilmember Sampson stated that he would like someone from the City to go to Nashville to find out about the continuation of the Pine Ridge Road project. He stated that he would recommend Bobby Tidwell, City Coordinator to go and one other city official.

**Retreat**-Councilmember Sampson stated that since the City Coordinator is now established that he would like to have a retreat to possibly put together a five-year plan. Mayor Davis asked Councilmember Tedder to find out the dates that would be available at Roane State and to let Tracey Bolden, City Clerk know so she could contact someone at MTAS to come and moderate the retreat.

**Midtown Sewer**-Councilmember Sampson stated that he would like to have the sewer service run under Highway 70 to help promote the land that is available for commercial use in Midtown. Councilmember Sampson stated that council needed to contact either Harriman Utility Board or the county regarding this matter. Mayor Davis stated that he would be meeting County Mayor Mike Farmer soon and would inquire about the sewer.


**Urban Growth Plan**-Mayor Davis asked for a motion to accept the urban growth map that will include the new parcels added at the request of Mr. Gary Mullins.
