

**SPECIAL CALL
APRIL 21, 2011**

The Harriman City Council met in a special call session April 21, 2011 at 6:00 P.M. in the City Municipal Complex. Mayor Mason was present and presiding. Mayor Mason called meeting to order. Roll call of Council was as follows:

Second reading of Ordinance 0311-02: An Ordinance prohibiting the use of certain Vehicles on Certain Secondary Streets in the City of Harriman

Mayor Mason yielded the floor to Harold Balcom. Harold read the ordinance allowed for everyone. Mayor Mason asked for the will of the council. Councilmember Sampson made a motion to approve the second reading of ordinance 0311-02. This was seconded by Councilmember Holley. Councilmember Wright made sure this ordinance was only giving the council the authority to put signs up on certain streets or sections of streets. Mayor Mason stated this would give them the authority for the whole city but they would only do this where there is a problem. Councilmember Wright asked if they would have to come up with some guidelines for which street. Councilmember Sampson stated they should be able to rely on the street department supervisor's recommendation. After much discussion the motion passed with a unanimous roll call "Yes"

Reading of Resolution R0411-01: A Resolution Proposing the Extension of the Corporate Limits of Harriman, Tennessee by the Annexation of Territory Adjoining its Existing Boundaries and Adopting a Plan of Services therefore

Harold Balcom read the resolution aloud for everyone. Harold stated the plan of services were standard for any annexation. Harold reported Maria and he worked very hard to make sure everything was correct. He gave an explanation about the map attached to the ordinance and which properties were going to be annexed. He stated most properties are under contract with the city to be annexed. Mayor Mason asked for a motion to approve resolution R0411-01. Councilmember Sampson made the motion and this was seconded by Councilmember Holley. After brief discussion the motion passed with a unanimous roll call "Yes".

Board Appointment for the Industrial Development Board

Mayor Mason reported he will skip this item and will bring it back at a later date.

Mayor Mason reported no other business can be discussed at a Special Call meeting and asked for a motion to adjourn. Councilmember Mynatt made the motion and this was seconded by Councilmember Sampson. The motion passed with a unanimous "Aye".
